

GRCBC Breeders List Policy

1. Breeders must be active members of the GRCBC in good standing for at least 5 years.
2. Breeders must be current members of the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. **As outlined in the GRCBC Code of Ethics**, Breeders must provide to all puppy buyers:
 - An appropriate certificate of examination of hip, elbow and heart clearances for both sire and dam.
 - Current annual eye clearances for sire and dam.
 - Results of any DNA testing recommended for Golden Retriever breeding stock
4. Puppies must be raised and sold according to our Club's code of ethics.
5. Litters from Breeders listed on the list must be owned, whelped and raised at the home of the Breeder (with the exception of c-sections).
6. Enquiries for puppies generated from the Breeders List on the GRCBC website must not be passed on to non-club members.
7. During the 12 month period prior to being listed on the Breeders List, Breeders in the Lower Mainland between Horseshoe Bay Chilliwack inclusive must ASSIST at a minimum of 3 club functions, 2 of which may be attending club meetings. Breeders living outside the Lower Mainland must ASSIST at a minimum of 2 club functions which may include, but not limited to attending meetings, articles for the newsletter, items for the silent auction and assisting at events in their areas (or any area). "Event" means any event sponsored by the GRCBC. Check the newsletter for any events or committees coming up that you might contribute to.
8. Breeders may not take deposits (but can take names) from puppy buyers prior to the breeding taking place.
9. The cost to be listed on the Breeders list will be \$35.00 annually. Breeders listed on the Breeders list will also have the option of listing litters on the Puppy list by following the current Puppy list requirements and paying the current Puppy List fee.
10. Breeders must adhere strictly to the rules as listed above and the GRCBC Code of Ethics. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action, up to and including suspension from the Breeders list and the loss of GRCBC membership.
